



Storm Water Seasonal Intern

Butler County Storm Water District has an opening for a Seasonal Intern to assist in the investigation and evaluation of facts and data, enforcement of compliance to the county's storm water management plan as part of the State of Ohio's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination Systems (NPDES) Phase II permit program. Work will consist of storm sewer outfall inventory, inspection, monitoring and enforcement of the county's Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination (IDDE) regulation.

Essential Functions: Must be able to...

- Lift manhole lids, storm sewer grates, etc. weighing at least 25 lbs.
- Navigate difficult terrain through construction sites, creeks, streams, etc.
- Be exposed to harsh environmental forces for extended periods of time.
- Perform dry weather inspections for non-storm water flows.
- Respond to public inquiries and complaints regarding illicit discharge, open dumping or other related pollutant sources as they affect water quality.
- Maintain a (GIS) outfall map consisting of municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4)
- Assist with construction and post-construction site inspections as they pertain to the NPDES program and local storm water regulations.
- Provide a summary report to the Storm Water Coordinator outlining events, inventory, illicit discharges detected, enforcement actions and number of non-compliant outfalls.
- Perform duties as necessary or incidental to the proper performance of this position.
- Comply with Safety Requirements including wearing proper safety equipment as required by OSHA, BCEO and District safety policy.

Desired Knowledge and Skills:

- Knowledge of NPDES program, regulations, goals and objectives of the Storm Water District.
- Knowledge of PCs and software – specifically Arc GIS, GPS equipment, water quality testing equipment and chemicals.
- Understand and read blueprint drawings for storm sewer, sanitary and water systems.
- Effective oral and written communication and record keeping.

Qualifications:

- Must be enrolled in a full time College or University program. Preferred major in Environmental Science, Biology, Chemistry, Hydrology/Hydrogeology, Geology, Engineering or other science field.
- Must have a valid State of Ohio driver's license with less than six points.
- Must be able to successfully complete a post-offer substance abuse test and background investigation.

Period of Employment:

- This is a temporary position. 40 hours per week, not to exceed 12 weeks.
